Iron	A meta that is harder that copper and bonze.
Celts	Warrior people who lived in Europe during the Iron Age
Hill Fort	A settlement placed on a high hill that is easy to defend from enemies.
Tribe	A group of people who lived in the same settlement ruled by a Chief
Chief	The leader of a tribe.
Warriors	People who fought. They defended their settlements against other tribes.

The Iron Age Period started in around 1200 BCE, when people started using metal.
