Mountain	A mountain is a part of Earth that is very wide, has a taller height than a hill and often has steep sides.
Mam Tor	Mother Hill.
Valley	A long ditch between two hills or mountains.
Summit Peak	The highest point of a mountain.
Ridge	Part of the steep, sloping sides of a mountain.
Cliff	Tall steep rocks with vertical faces.
Hill	A high landform but not as high as a mountain
Range	A group or chain of mountains.
