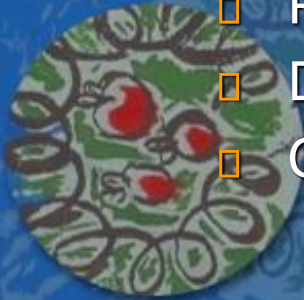

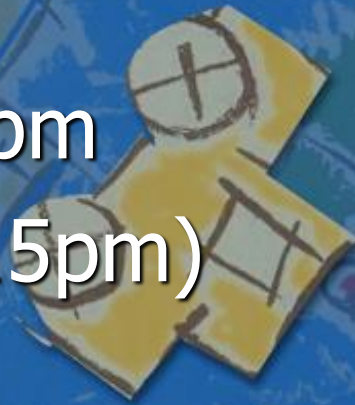

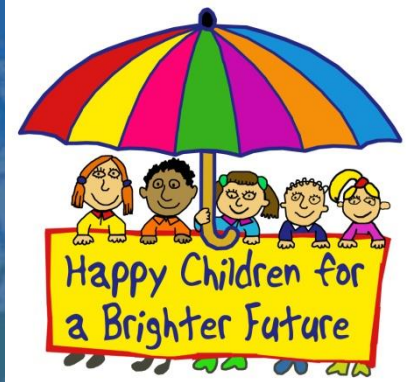

- ❑ Burgundy **V-neck sweatshirt**, or cardigan (with or without logo)

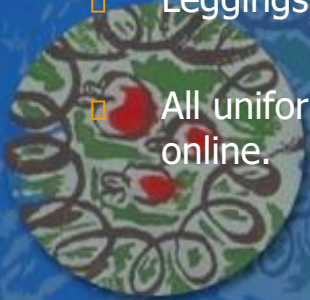
- ❑ **Y5 and Y6 boys and girls**

Other Equipment

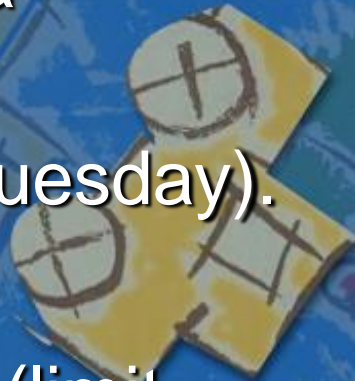
- PE kit
